DAILY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Cleaning and sanitizing of mix and run vessels and auxiliary equipment
- Assist other compounders in batch manufacturing, line set-up and related paper work
- Drums off concentrate and raw materials as needed
- Learns proper use of all process equipment
- Operates Lift truck in a safe manner
- Manufactures batches in accordance with the PI and the SOP's
- Possesses working knowledge of all applicable Good Manufacturing Practices, Quality Assurance, Micro, Hygiene, and Sanitization Procedures, as well as all Standard Operating Procedures
- Observes all safety rules and guidelines for handling of hazardous chemicals
- Maintains clean, sanitary and organized work areas at all times
- Promptly returns all used chemicals or ingredients from the assigned work area to the staging areas
- Weighs out ingredients to be used in batching
- Any other duties assigned to him by the team leader, shift supervisor, or Operations Manager
- Perform daily safety inspection and complete associated documentation
- Pass, maintain, and support all chlorine safety training offered by corporate safety team
- Maintain high level of security in assigned chemical area
- Perform preventative maintenance in processing area with related equipment and controls
- Perform repair maintenance as necessary in assigned area
- Work with railroad on switches of railcars
- Work with bulk loads suppliers of unloading and/or loading of bulk OTR shipments as planned

Requirements

- 1 – 3 years bleach experience desired.
- Problem solving includes calculating ingredients for processing, identifying equipment problems, and reporting issues to supervisor.
- The ability to drive a forklift, read, write, and perform basic math. Use of some judgment to comply with instructions and prescribed routines. Practical application of knowledge of the blending system is critical. The ability to read, understand and interpret the impact of gauges and monitors on the system. Basic maintenance for repairs and replacing pipes and hoses. The ability to meet quality standards, follow safety rules, company policies and procedures and the ability to work in a team environment.
